#### **Annual Scientific Meeting:**

SAIMA held its Annual Scientific Meeting at the prestigious Adelaide Oval, delivering a morning of high-yield education and professional development for the South Australian medical community.

The event commenced with a welcome and opening remarks from Dr Alka Garg and Dr Tharapriya Ramkumar, settingthe tone for a dynamic program focused on medico-legal awareness, technological innovation, and current clinical challenges.

#### Session 1 Highlights

The first session explored evolving issues at the intersection of medicine, law, and innovation:

- Paula Meegan (MIGA) presented on Artificial Intelligence-Based Medical Scribing Tools (AI Scribes) and the associated medico-legal considerations.
- Mark Helier (MIGA) followed with an insightful overview of Medico-legal
   Principles and Handling Complaints a critical area for all practicing clinicians.
- The final talk of the session by Dr Matthew Hong addressed PSA Testing to Screen for Prostate Cancer, bridging population health with urological screening controversies.

After a brief Q&A and tea break, delegates enjoyed networking opportunities and visited sponsor exhibits, reflectingSAIMA's commitment to fostering collaboration across healthcare sectors.

# Session 2 Highlights

The second session, moderated by Dr Dildeepa Naveen and Dr Preetam Ganu, showcased diverse clinical updates:

- Dr Raghu Gowda delivered an important update on Radiotherapy for Prostate Carcinoma.
- Dr Samantha Pillay discussed Incontinence in Women for GPs, providing practical takeaways for primary care.
- Dr Varun Malik rounded out the session with an engaging presentation on Contemporary Atrial Fibrillation and HeartFailure Management.
- The final presentation was from Adelaide PHN, strengthening links between clinical practice and primary healthnetworks.
- The ASM concluded with lunch and sponsor exhibit browsing, allowing for continued networking in a relaxed atmosphere. With its wellcurated content, multidisciplinary relevance, and vibrant community participation, the SAIMA ASM 2025 was a resounding success and a proud reflection of SAIMA's mission to support clinical excellence and community engagement.
